Choose at least 5 courses from the options below. Please note the following:

- The options that you indicate below are a request only. Your college counselor will advise you on the courses that best fit your academic needs.
- You must take 5 full-year courses each year: English, Math, Science, Social Science, and one elective (can be two one-semester electives). You may choose one additional course to have a full (6 class) schedule.
- We are unable to permit class selections based on teacher or time preferences.
- Class changes are permitted only during the add/drop period.
- Teacher assignments are not guaranteed for an entire term.
- The Academy reserves the right to make adjustments at any time, particularly when new faculty are added or to maintain appropriate class sizes.
- All students are required to participate in our Advisory program, which will be reflected on the student’s transcript. Advisory does not count toward the 5 course requirement. See curriculum guide for more details.
- Eligible middle school students may take a maximum of two high school credits per year. Please see your college counselor for more details.
- Grade levels for courses listed below are general guidelines only. Each student’s academic path may vary depending on courses previously taken and pre-requisite requirements.
- Please refer to the Curriculum Guide for more details about graduation requirements and individual courses.
