IMG Academy offers dual enrollment and post graduate college courses through our partnership with Barry University.

The dual enrollment program is an opportunity to take challenging courses and accelerate educational opportunities.

- Students who successfully complete dual enrollment courses will save time and money toward their college degree with free tuition and textbooks.
- Dual enrollment courses are college courses and the amount of work necessary to succeed in dual enrollment courses may be much greater than in high school courses. **Dual enrollment courses become part of a student's permanent college transcript and are calculated into the student's permanent postsecondary GPA.**
- Dual enrollment courses are for one semester unless otherwise indicated.
- The transferability of credits is determined by the matriculating institution.
- PG students take a maximum of three college courses per semester.

Who is eligible to participate in dual enrollment classes?

- 11th and 12th grade student-athletes
 - Availability of dual enrollment courses for high school students will be prioritized based on class size and student need.
- 3.0 unweighted GPA (for high school students only)
